With a scholarship from the Faculty of Business Administration, Kasetsart University he further obtained his MBA and Ph.D. in Accounting, from the University of Oregon, U.S.A.

After completing his doctorate, he accepted an invitation to serve as a Visiting Assistant Professor at the Lundquist College of Business, University of Oregon for a year, and has since then served as a faculty member at the Faculty of Business and Administration, Kasetsart University. Recently, he has been appointed as Associate Dean for Accounting and Treasury.

Sansakrit also serves under the Federation of Accounting Professions in the capacity of a member of the steering committee on IFRS monitoring, the working group to review the Thai Financial Reporting Standards, as well as the committee on development of accounting guidelines for SMEs.

With teaching interests in the areas of financial reporting and analysis and management accounting, Sansakrit is often invited to conduct training courses on such topics for both public and private organizations such as Thailand Securities Institute of the Stock Exchange of Thailand, Bangkok Bank PCL, Grant Thornton (Thailand), The Provincial Electricity Authority (PEA), and Ministry of Public Health. His research interests are on financial capital markets and auditing. He was a co-author on an audit research, entitled "The Interaction between Internal Control Assessment and Substantive Testing in Audits for Fraud," which was published in Contemporary Accounting Research in year 2000.
