Visarut Sribunnak joined Chulalongkorn Business School faculty in 1995 and is currently serving as a member of the Federation of Accounting Professions' steering committees on IFRS monitoring, and development of accounting guidelines for SMEs, as well as the working group to review the Thai Financial Reporting Standards.

Upon completion of the Bachelor of Accountancy degree program with honors from Chulalongkorn University, Visarut immediately joined Ernst & Young in Bangkok. He further earned his MBA from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign with an academic excellence award, and his Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley.

Visarut's research focuses on capital markets and the usefulness of accounting information. He was a winner of the manuscript award from the KPMG & University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign Business Measurement Program with his coauthored work on the usefulness of foreign exchange sensitivity-analysis risk disclosures, which was published in a 2006 issue of the Journal of Accounting Auditing and Finance. He has recently coauthored a book on foreign exchange derivatives and hedge accounting. In addition, he has frequently been invited as a speaker on financial instruments and other financial reporting issues for the Federation of Accounting Professions, Bank of Thailand, Thailand Securities Institute of the Stock Exchange of Thailand and leading private organizations such as Siam Cement Group and Kasikorn Bank.
